KANKAKEE, IL – In an ongoing effort to openly communicate with the public, the Kankakee County State's Attorneys' Office has launched a redesigned website that offers a wide range of information about the work of the office and criminal court proceedings. The public is invited to explore the website at www.K3SAO.com.

The newly redesigned and expanded website features a more modern and user-friendly format, allowing people to quickly and easily access needed information. Visitors to the site can learn about the State's Attorney's priorities, programs, and resources available to victims; high-school seniors, college and law school students can apply for an internship with the office; taxpayer watchdogs can report suspected corruption; and witnesses can submit anonymous tips regarding an unsolved crime. There is also a contact form to request a prosecutor to speak at a community meeting.



“This website demonstrates our ongoing commitment to fostering an open flow of information between my office and the community,” said Kankakee County State's Attorney Jim Rowe. “The website will be ever-evolving, and I encourage residents to offer ideas on how we can better use technology and this website to improve transparency and access to information.”
